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#### TE AO MAORI @ LSS

Mihi Whakatau Process - Here at LSS, we begin the term with either a pōwhiri, or a mihi whakatau. Each term, these will be held on the first Wednesday back at school, starting at 11am. All school whānau are welcome to attend. The first one for 2024 was held vesterday with the whole school in attendance to welcome not just our new tamariki and their whānau, but our new staff as well. The main difference between a powhiri and a mihi whakatau is that while a pōwhiri may be conducted on a Marae, a mihi whakatau can be done in other locations and may not feature a karanga (the call of the woman). In this case the mihi whakatau is still an official welcome for all new students and whānau. It removes the tapu (restrictions) of the manuhiri (visitors) to make them one with the tangata whenua (hosts). We are very fortunate to have the capability to carry these long held traditions with the blessings of the local mana whenua. A huge thanks to Whaea Sarah and Pā Matt for carrying some of these roles on behalf of those attending. We look forward to sharing events such as these with as many of you as possible in the future.
