125TH CELEBRATION - TALES FROM THE ARCHIVES

A bronze memorial plaque, donated by the LSS Old Pupils Association was dedicated by the Reverend Keith Elliot VC, who was a former pupil and unveiled by Mrs J.W Bramwell, a relative of Percy Bramwell, who had been the first ex-pupil to make the supreme sacrifice in World War I. The inscription read, "In Memory of All Teachers and Ex-Pupils of This School who served their King and country on the land, on the sea, and in the air in the Great Wars of 1914-1918 and 1939-1945. The names are many - We Will Remember Them." This plaque is still at the school to this day.
